To support our families, we are providing a **FREE Mental Health and Well-being Library**, featuring over 70 on-demand courses in English and Spanish, covering topics such as Anxiety, Depression, Bullying, and more.

Additionally, we are launching a **Mental Health Series** for parents, offering virtual events led by licensed therapists. These sessions provide practical advice on supporting your child's mental health and fostering a supportive parental community.

The **Ask a Therapist Live** feature allows parents to receive expert answers to their questions about their child's mental health, either anonymously or by listening to others.

We also offer **Parent Coaching** services, where coaches provide personalized support and practical strategies for various parenting challenges, all while ensuring privacy under HIPAA regulations.
